
## RING SIZING GUIDE

#### **CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE**





Read Size Here

- Ring measurements are very precise. Carefully follow these instructions to obtain an
  accurate measurement.
- 2. **Prior to printing,** ensure that Page Scaling is set to "None" on your print dialog box. (To open the print dialog box, press CTRL+P.)
- Measure the bar on the left. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. Alternately,
  place a quarter where indicated. The quarter should fit completely over the image so
  that all lines are covered, without the quarter hanging over any edges.

### **OPTION A** - Paper Ring Sizer

- 1. Print and cut out ring sizer below. Cut a small slit where indicated at the thicker end.
- 2. Slide the pointed end of the ring sizer through the slit you cut.
- 3. Slide sizer past your knuckle and tightly secure around the base of your finger.
- 4. The number that apears where it says "Read Size Here" is your approximate ring size.

# **OPTION B** - Measure an Existing Ring

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diamater of the ring.
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
